

The Graduate School, Prince of Songkla University has allocated funding for the PSU-Graduate Studies Scholarship in the Academic Year 2025. Therefore, calls for Applications are hereby invited for the aforementioned scholarships. The details of the funding are as follows:

1. Number of Scholarships

- 1.1 Doctoral Level: 60 scholarships.
- 1.2 Master's level: 20 scholarships

2. Duration of the Scholarship

- 2.1 For Doctoral Students:
 - 3 academic years for Master's Degree-based
 - 4 academic years for Doctoral Degree-based
- 2.2 For Master's Students:
 - 2 academic years

3. Scholarship Support: These expenses cover the entire scholarship period as follows:

- 3.1 Monthly expenses as a lump sum payment.
 - Doctoral Degree Level: 12,000 THB/month
 - Master's Degree level: 8,500 THB/month

Remarks: In case of international students, the scholarship will be disbursed monthly expenses upon the recipient's arrival in Thailand for the remaining months of the scholarship period only.

4. Applicant Qualifications

- 4.1 Applicants must be Thai or international students enrolling in a doctoral or master's program at Prince of Songkla University in the academic year 2025 with a thesis or dissertation plan.
- 4.2 International applicants must reside on campus and attend classes full-time in order to be eligible for scholarships and conduct their research data collection within Thailand only.
- 4.3 Applicants must not receive any other scholarships that cover tuition fees and/or provide a monthly expense. If found otherwise, the full scholarship amount must be refunded.
- 4.4 Applicants must have a GPA of at least 3.00 or an academic performance of at least 75% and be able to conduct full-time research until graduation.
- 4.5 Additional qualifications are subject to the discretion of the Dean of the Graduate School.

5. Required Documents

- 5.1 Scholarship application form
- 5.2 A brief research proposal in A4 not over 10 pages
- 5.3 English language proficiency test scores (PSU-TEP, CU-TEP, TOEFL, TOEFL-ITP, IELTS)
- 5.4 Research works and publications (if any)

6. Scholarship Conditions

- 6.1 The grantee must pass the English language requirement as per the graduation criteria of the Graduate School and/or the program requirements (PSU-TEP, CU-TEP, TOEFL, IELTS) by **November 30, 2025**.
- 6.2 The grantee must submit the progress report and study results every 6 months using the provided format form within the specified deadline, 2 times in each academic year through the Graduate School's scholarship request system at https://grad-mis.psu.ac.th/scholarship/, namely.
 - ➤ 1st round on December 10
 - \triangleright 2nd round on June 10
- 6.3 The grantee must have publications in reputable international peer-reviewed journals that are recognized in international databases, according to the criteria set by the Civil Service Commission in Higher Education Institutions (OCSC) before graduation, as follows:
 - Field of Science and Technology and Health Sciences: 2 publications for doctoral level, 1 publication for master level (all levels indexed by Web of Science)
 - ➤ Field of Humanities and Social Sciences: 2 publications for doctoral level, 1 publication for master level (all levels indexed by Scopus (Q1 or Q2))
- 6.4 The grantee who are employed and receiving a salary during their studies will not be eligible for the living allowance portion of the scholarship.
- 6.5 The grantee shall state in the publication acknowledgement section of the thesis that the study is funded by "the PSU-Graduate Studies Scholarship in the year xxxx" or a similar context.
- 6.6 The grantee must submit reprints of their international journals as required in 6.3, along with the published research, to close the scholarship account.

9. Announcement of Interview Candidates and Grantees

If applicants fail to check the announcement or do not attend the interview at the scheduled date and time, they will be considered to have forfeited their eligibility without any right of appeal.
